The 33 rd British National Championships 2024 'Michael Flatley's Freestyle Steps'

THE PERFORMANCE:

Perform a 16-bar reel OR slip jig step in soft OR hard shoe. The step can be divided and danced in the normal format of right and left foot or different choreography for the entire 16 bars is also acceptable.

The format will resemble a 'step down the line.'

The core style of the 16-bar routine performed for 'freestyle steps' must be Irish dance. Participants are challenged to explore the blending of traditional Irish dancing with progressive upper body and head movements to create a unique interpretation of Irish Dancing in a manner that broadens our artform. Articulation and execution of footwork, timing, and rhythm are of the upmost importance.

AGE GROUPS:

Separate age groups for U10, U11, U12, U13, U14, U15, U16, U17 17 & Over - COMBINED

ALL 'FREESTYLE STEPS' COMPETITONS WILL BE ON THE SAME DAY AS THEIR REGULAR COMPETITION AFTER ALL THREE ROUNDS AND BEFORE THE MAIN RESULTS THIS COMPETITION IS OPEN TO DANCERS, WHO ARE NOT PERFORMING IN THE MAIN COMPETITION AT THE BN, WHO MUST BE OPEN / CHAMPIONSHIP LEVEL.

THE COMPETITON

No video entry required. Entry is £5 for all categories.

Wear black workout clothing or similar. Black trousers, shirts, leotards are all acceptable. Logos should be small/preferably not visible. Strictly no solo/class costumes, school logo's/colours/names/ symbols or initials should be visible.

The competition with be adjudicated by a panel of three adjudicators and results will be tabulated as they are for all other competitions.

The results will not be published or available to purchase. The top three competitors from each category will be awarded on stage with a commemorative custom made 'Michael Flatley Freestyle' medal.

All competitors should be aware that this event will be recorded. Submitting your entry is confirmation of your agreement to share your individual image, dance choreography / material and video clips that may be used for television / promotional / cultural use on behalf of the British National Championships, Lord of the Dance and Feis TV.

2024 BRITISH NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS - RULES OF THE COMPETITION

- 1 A dancer's age group will be determined as from 1st January 2024.
- Entries will only be accepted from dancing teachers registered with An Coimisiún Le Rinci Gaelacha for the year 2023/2024 only.
- The adjudicators' decision is final. Only members of the NW Teachers Association and those officially assisting them in the running of the championships may approach the adjudicators during competitions.
- Complaints will only be accepted from registered teachers, in writing, and must be accompanied by a fee of £50.00, which may be refunded if the North West Teachers Association upholds said objection.
- Teachers are advised that all details required on the entry forms must be completed. Entry forms received in contravention of this rule will be returned.
- All competitors must be ready to dance 30 minutes prior to the published time. They must also report to the stage stewards promptly and dance in the prescribed order. Failure to report in time to dance in order will lead to disqualification. Competitors are strongly advised to check the timetable for last-minute changes to times or halls, both leading up to the event and on the day of competition.
- In all rounds, the minimum speeds of music as laid down by An Coimisiún will apply.
- The recall in solo championships will be as follows –

Under 6, 7, 8 & 9 – 100% Recall

From Under 10 upwards there will be a 50% recall if there are 21 or more dancers in a championship. * NW Teachers Association reserve the right to amend this percentage.

The onus of ensuring that the stage steward is informed of the correct name and metronomic speed of the nominated open set dance will rest with the competitor.

An incorrect metronomic speed submitted for an open set dance can only be changed prior to the commencement of the open set dance round.

Introduction to open set dances will be played only once and no alteration in that speed of music will be permitted.

Should a competitor commence dancing to an incorrect metronomic speed submitted to the stage steward then that competitor must continue to dance at that speed as no further opportunity of tempo change will be afforded.

- In the event of a mishap on stage, e.g. a heel or shoe coming off, the dancer should retire to the back of the stage and remain there, allowing the other dancer(s) to continue with their performance. If a dancer fails to comply with this direction and leaves the stage, then he/she will be deemed to have failed to complete the round and will be eliminated from the championship
- Should a dancer fall, and the stage situation be that he/she inhibits the performance or safety of other dancers on stage, the bell <u>must</u> be rung, and the group will be permitted to dance again. If a dancer falls during the last 8 bars of their dance, they will re-dance the last 16 Bars. Otherwise the FULL dance will be re-danced.
- If a competitor sustains injury or illness during the course of a competition, and the organisers have reason to believe that such an illness or injury could be exacerbated by continued participation, he/she will be advised to retire from the competition. If this advice is ignored, then prior to continuation, the dancer (or in the case of a child or young person (5 to 17 years) an appropriate adult) will be required to sign a disclaimer form, which will be retained in the event of a possible future enquiry.

2024 BRITISH NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS - RULES OF THE COMPETITION

- Any competitors found to be using artificial carriage aids will be requested to remove same. In the case of refusal, disqualification will follow. In the case of medical apparatus, this will be permitted upon the production of a letter from a medical practitioner or other documentary evidence in support, to prove authenticity and the requirement for the aid to be used or worn.
- Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability of capturing a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means, e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden during competitions. Photographs taken at awards ceremonies are permitted. However, these must be for your own use, and not for public display purposes unless permission has been obtained
- The rules of CLRG as regards standards of dress must be adhered to in public areas of the venue; discretion must be exerted when dancers are changing for competitions. Changing areas will be provided.
- Dancers taking part in results ceremonies will not be permitted to go onto stage to receive any award unless in full costume and wearing **black dance shoes.**
- All dancers deserve the same respect and ovation on completion of their performance. Excessive and unique verbal celebrations will not be tolerated on completion of a performance.
- All cups and shields are perpetual awards. These are the responsibility of the holder for the relevant year, who is responsible for loss and any damage not previously reported. Such cups and shields must be returned in good time for the corresponding competitions next year.
- With respect to team competitions, please refer to the rules in the An Coimisiún syllabus for Oireachtas Rince Na Cruinne 2024.
- The NW Teachers Association have made every effort to ensure that the stages are of the correct specification in design and structure, taking into account health and safety issues. All stages are covered with Harlequin flooring. By entering the championships, competitors accept that neither the NW Teachers Association or the Bolton Stadium Hotel can't be held liable for any incident or event which could not be reasonably foreseen.
- In the event of a dispute not covered by any of the rules of these championship, reference will be made to the Rules of An Coimisiún, appertaining to the issue or matter in dispute.

Performance related rules.

- In all heavy dances the lead-round must be danced on both right and left feet.
- Competitors will dance the following :
 - U6 & U7 40 bars in reel, single jig, light jig & Heavy Jig (all 2/3 dances must be danced) U8 & U9 40 bars in reel and heavy jig and Traditional Set Dance (all 3 dances must be danced).
 - U10 Senior 48 bars in the reel and heavy Jig, 40 bars in the slip jig and hornpipe
- A dancer who fails to dance or complete rounds one or two of a championship will receive **ZERO** marks from all Adjudicators for that round, and will not feature in the recall. Where there is 100% recall the competitor will be allowed to dance the third round as a courtesy, but will not appear in the final result. This includes competitors who do not complete the correct amount of bars by starting either before or after the 8 bar introduction.
- A competitor who fails to dance or complete the open set dance round will receive ZERO marks from all championship adjudicators for that round and will not appear in the final result. This includes Competitors who do not complete the correct amount of bars by starting either before or after the 8 bar introduction.

General Conduct

- Your attention is drawn to the legal position with regard to smoking in public places or buildings in England. The Bolton Stadium Hotel is designated as such a public place, and smoking is therefore forbidden in all parts of the building. It is further recommended that hair spray and similar cosmetic or hygienic spray substances should not be used in the public area(s) within the venue.
- In the event of unacceptable behaviour in the venue on the part of any member of the Irish dancing community, for the duration of the Championships, the Bolton Stadium Hotel management reserve the right to deal with those who are responsible in accordance with their policies appertaining to such situations. The NW Teachers will support such action with regard to unacceptable behaviour.

SECONDARY QUALIFICATION RULES FOR OIREACHTAS RINCE NA CRUINNE 2025

Qualifiers are based on the number who actually dance from England, Wales, Scotland & RCCEA, **not the number of dancers registered.** Qualifying Age Groups are from Under 10 to Senior.

2024 World Medal Holders will be counted as participants at subsequent qualifying events, but not as qualifiers. Should a 2024 World Medal Holder finish in a qualifying position at a subsequent qualifying event, they will be 'skipped over' and their qualifying place will be passed to the next dancer in that result. Therefore, should a particular 2024 World Medal Holder not participate at a subsequent qualifying event, an additional qualifying place is not created.

The number of qualifiers from the corresponding competitions at a National Oireachtas shall be as follows:

A -In the case of the Senior Men's Championship, there shall be seven (7) where the number of participants is twenty or fewer, plus one additional qualifier for each five (5), or part thereof, in excess of the first twenty competitors (20 or less = 7, 21 to 25 = 8, 26 to 30 = 9, 31 to 35 = 10);

B - In the case of all other Solo Championships (from Under 10 and up), there shall be five (5) where the number of participants is twenty or fewer, plus one additional qualifier for each ten (10) or part thereof in excess of the 1st twenty competitors (20 or less=5, 21 to 30 = 6, 31 = 7, 41 = 7, 41 = 8, 51 = 8, 51 = 9, 61 = 7, 61 = 10, 61 = 1

Qualification at a National Oireachtas is only available to those who normally reside in that area.

Residents of Great Britain, Mainland Europe, Russia, Asia and the Middle East (the Scottish Nationals, or the Great Britian Championships, or the British Nationals – depending on which event has qualification status for that particular year). The 2024 British Nationals is the qualifying event for Oireachtas Rince na Cruinne 2025.

Qualifiers from a National Oireachtas do not create additional qualifying places at a Regional Oireachtas

All qualifying events must meet the following criteria for the results to be validated by An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha (unless written permission is sought from, and granted by An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha:

- A The event must be held no later than 31st December 2024 (unless written permission is granted by the Oireachtas Chairperson);
- B The event must be held in accordance with the Rules and Directives of An Coimisiún le Rincí Gaelacha;
- C The age groups and required heavy/light dances must correspond with the World Championships for which the dancers are aiming to qualify.
- D Results, including marks, must be posted to regional/national/event websites within fourteen (14) days of the completion of the Oireachtas;
- E A list of all qualifiers and any other requested information, must be received by the CLRG Office Staff.

- It is the responsibility of the teacher to ensure that the email or the posted entry submitted is correct. When the confirmation email is received, names and dates of birth must be carefully checked. Spellings etc. as submitted by the teacher will be that which appears in the official programme.
- Incomplete entries will not be accepted. All dancers' names and dates of birth must be submitted by the closing date.

U6 to U9 Championships will commence with the Light Round (Reel). U6 Championship will have 3 adjudicators for the Reel and 3 Adjudicators for the Single Jig, 6 in total. Each Championship from Under 7 will have 9 adjudicators, a separate panel of 3 for each round.

There will be a **100%** Recall in the U6 to U9 Championships. From Under 10 upwards there will be a **50%** recall if there are 21 or more dancers in a championship. **NW Teachers Association reserve the right to amend this percentage (Rule 8).**
